

Detailed instructions on how to fill out the online application

First Step:

On the first page fill in all of the blank and drop-down cells, there are 3 pages you must click next at the bottom of each page to be able to continue.

Our branch is listed as 01-091 Prince Edward, and our fees are \$65 a year. **PLEASE ENSURE YOU IDENTIFY BRANCH 91 TO ENSURE YOUR MEMBERSHIP GOES TO OUR BRANCH** this will eliminate time waiting for your card. Next Step:

On page two, you can see the red arrows that indicate where you must use the drop-down menu to choose your membership type. Please read the descriptions below to ensure you choose the correct type of membership. There is an option to renew automatically but as this is an option you do not have to choose this.

There are four different types of memberships (**please read carefully and chose the option that suits you, - you may only choose 1 option**):

1. Ordinary – Reserve C Class, Wartime, Can. Reg Force, His Majesty’s Reg. Force, Reserve, NATO, RCMP, R.N.F. Constabulary, Wartime Allied Force, Underground Force, Coast Guard, NORAD, US Force, Vietnam, Police Force, Cadet Instructor Cadre (CIC), Non-military – which includes Air Raid Wardens, Canadian Fire Fighters Corps, Ferry Command, Fishery Patrol, Home Guard, Knights of Columbus, Legion War Service, Merchant Navy, National Fire Services, Naval Auxiliary. Overseas Forestry Units, Red Cross, Reserve and deep see salvage tugs, Saint John Ambulance, Salvation Army, War Correspondents, Women’s Land Army, Y.M.C.A – this does not include civilians that worked for DND.
2. Associate - spouse, widow/er, parent, child, grandchild, sibling, niece/nephew of a person who is/was eligible for Ordinary membership or associate membership. Federal or Provincial Emergency Response Service, Polish Armed Forces. You will need to Indicate relationship.
3. Affiliate Voting: Canadian citizen or Commonwealth subject from an Allied nation and support the aims and objects of The Royal Canadian Legion.
4. Affiliate Non-Voting: A non-Canadian citizen or a non-Commonwealth subject form an Allied nation and support the aims and objects of The Royal Canadian Legion.

Categories of membership

Any Canadian citizen or citizen of an Allied nation who is 18 years of age or older is welcome to become a member of the Legion. There are four main categories of membership:

- **Ordinary membership** [Read More]
Includes still serving and retired military, reservists, RCMP, police officers, Canadian Coast Guard, and others listed in the General By-Laws.
- **Associate membership** [Read More]
Includes parents, spouses, widows, widowers, children, grandchildren, siblings, nieces as well as nephews of a person who is or was eligible for Ordinary membership.
- **Affiliate voting membership** [Read More]
Includes Canadian citizens or Commonwealth subjects from an Allied nation who support The Royal Canadian Legion's aims and objectives and are not eligible for ordinary or associate membership.
- **Affiliate non-voting membership** [Read More]
Includes non-Canadian citizens or non-Commonwealth subjects from an Allied nation who support The Royal Canadian Legion's aims and objectives.

Other programs that are available are the Veteran Welcome and Veteran Family Welcome Program: These offer a first free year for Veterans their parents, guardians, spouses and children 18+ of serving, retired or passed CAF and RCMP members who have '**never**' been a member of the Canadian Legion.

The branch will be notified of your new membership, and your membership card will be sent to us, and we will reach out to let you know when it is here.

Once you have your new card and membership number you can create an online portal for yourself where you can update your personal information i.e. address, email, phone number, opting for a digital card or renewing each year etc. as needed. This will be greatly appreciated by the Membership Team as it decreases workload of the volunteers at the branch level, it also ensures that you have control over your personal data without having to go through the team which can cause delays.
